Last May, Hydro Aluminium announced that the Kurri Kurri aluminium smelter would not be re-opened. We want to do what we can to make sure that the future for the region is bright. To achieve this, we are preparing the site and the 2000 hectare buffer zone for its future uses.

We are making plans for the demolition and remediation of the site, the rezoning of parcels of land for business and industrial uses as well as for residential development, and the conservation of around 1300 hectares of land.
