

Last May, Hydro Aluminium announced that the Kurri Kurri aluminium smelter would not be re-opened.

Hydro though wants to do what we can to make sure that the future for the region is bright, and is preparing the site and the 2000 hectare buffer zone for its future uses.

Hydro is making plans for the remediation of the site, the rezoning of parcels of land for both commercial and residential development, and the conservation of around 1300 hectares of land.

The smelter has had many owners, and the while Hydro is helping plan for the future, we know that the project will benefit the local community and the region.

To mark this new phase in the regions' history, Hydro is renaming the redevelopment project Regrowth Kurri Kurri. The name symbolises the new start for the site, and the promise of prosperous futures for residents, businesses, and for the environment.
