After decades of use by various owners, Hydro is proposing to move contaminated material and other general waste from several locations around the smelter and its buffer zone, and demolition waste from the smelter itself, to consolidate it all in one highly engineered containment cell.

The remediation will be an enabler for the conservation of a large proportion of the land, and the rezoning of other land parcels to allow business and industrial and residential development.

The final remediation project will require approval by the NSW Environment Protection Authority and the Department of Planning.
